Musical background

HC has played the recorder since early childhood in several classical ensembles, and has also dabbled in other instruments such as the clarinet, shawm and a lot of different flutes, pipes and other woodwind instruments. Started as a classical singer in a chamber choir in 1996 and has received training by several vocal instructors, including classical soprano Jette Rosendal in 2008. Had his first job as a musician as an assistant singer at The Royal Academy of Music, Aalborg in 1997. Employed as a singer at various Danish churches, Folkekirken 2007-2020. Working both as a church singer at church services and as a solo tenor at classical concerts.

Joined his first folk band Lurpakket in 2006 and started his career as a medieval folk musician performing at European Medieval Festival in Horsens, Copenhagen Historical Market, Aarhus Medieval Festival and a lot of similar festivals and events. Since then he has played a host of concerts, released five albums with his medieval / viking folk bands, composed and produced a lot of folk songs, and been a part of several interesting projects, including national TV productions.
